TIPS TO PREPARE FOR THE STORM

To Do List

Adhere to All Emergency Officials!
Fill Vehicles up with Gas
Get Cash, as ATMs may be down
Fill Bathtub with water to flush toilet
Start Taking Ice from Ice Maker and
..storing in bags in freezer between items
Prepare foods that will spoil
Turn Refrigerator to Coldest Setting
Freeze Ice in Mug then lay coin on top..
..place back in freezer. This is a good
sign of how long power was out.
Catch up on Laundry
Take Video/Photo Inventory of Home
Back up everything to the "cloud"
Take Out all Garbage
Cleanup Outside Your Home
Sandbags at base of doorways
Tape Windows with X / Board Up
Get electronics up off the ground
Unplug Electronics
Trim any large trees or shrubs
Clear Gutters of Debris
Reinforce Garage Door
Bring Outdoor Items Inside;
Secure All other Outdoor Items
Get Generator Ready
Do Not Wait, Evacuate.

Bug Repellent
Medical Equipment

Personal Hygiene Supplies & Toiletries
Bedding (Sleeping Bags, Pillows)
Trash Bags (Sturdy Kind)
Photo Identification
Proof of Occupancy
Water/Fireproof Container
Emergency Car Kit & Handy Tools
